The apprentice trip leader level is an evaluation of a trip leader candidate's personal readiness to begin trip leader development. Prior to becoming an assistant, individuals are considered apprentice trip leaders and are encouraged to participate in staff training exercises and leadership development. This level requires a commitment to being developed and trained by a Lifelines staff member.

Responsibilities:

- Take care of self without additional help from other leaders
- Serve as an aid to the Trip Leader helping with logistics
- Lead basic activities, one on one instruction, under supervision of Trip Leader
